You do not need to use your red, white, and blue Medicare card while on this plan, but please keep it for your records.
- You may use any doctor, hospital, or medical provider that accepts Medicare and is willing to submit the bill to Humana, even if they are not part of the Humana network. <u>The Local 5 plan</u> <u>provides the same medical benefit at in- and out-of-network providers</u>. This offers great flexibility on which doctors you can use.
- There is no annual deductible for the medical or prescription drug benefit. You also have out-of-pocket maximum protection which limits how much you have to spend on covered services and prescriptions throughout the year.
